FUTURE OF THE AUTOMOTIVE INDUSTRY Committee of the Regions Automotive Intergroup (CoRAI)

CoRAI is an interregional group of members of the European Committee of the Regions providing opportunities to discuss, exchange views and increase expertise on the Future of the Automotive Industry in order to promote cooperation between local and regional authorities. The aim is to connect CoR members from automotive regions with industry, clusters and experts of the EU Institutions.

CoRAI is a platform for informal discussion bringing together members from different parties, committees and member states being interested in future developments of the automotive and supply sector. It was set up in 2009 and is working successfully since then. The Chair of the group is Thomas Schmidt (DE/EPP). Together with the Automotive Regions Alliance, it is working on a successful transformation of the automotive sector.

The European automotive ecosystem represents 1.8 million companies, and at least 16 million people work in the sector. Regions with automotive industry and its suppliers are a fundamental part of regional economies. Therefore, the regions play a central role in the transformation that the automotive industry is facing due to the digitalization and greening of transport.
